

# **Bell-Air R/C Flyers (AMA Club Charter #654)**

## **Food Service Coordinator**

### **Overview:**

- The Bell-Air Food Service Coordinator is a volunteer position that answers to the club's Safety Officer. He/she will keep the position until such time as they no longer wish to continue. At that time, another volunteer will be asked for.
- The Food Service Coordinator will ensure sanitary conditions are provided at all club sponsored events involving food. A huge concern is the lack of running water at the field. Hand washing and/or sanitization must be implemented for any club sponsored event involving food consumption.
- No club sponsored food consumption events will be planned without a Food Service Coordinator volunteer in place.
- The Club Safety Officer shall fill the role of Food Service Coordinator if no one volunteers for the position.

### **Duties:**

- Provide hand washing stations with water, soaps, sanitizers, paper towels as required for all eating events. Club will reimburse any expenses.
- Monitor any food heating/cooling temperatures per the Whatcom Health Department guidelines when food is served or consumed at the field. Any food not at proper temperatures will not be served.
- Ensure any cooking equipment and utensils are properly maintained and thoroughly cleaned between uses.
- Ensure proper storage of any leftover consumable items.
- Arrange for catered food delivery when needed.
- Coordinate other volunteers for specific duties at catered or food service events.

### **Requirements:**

- The Food Service Coordinator must have a valid Washington State Food Worker Card. Courses and cards are available online at: <https://www.foodworkercard.wa.gov/>
- The Food Worker Card cost is \$10.00 for 2 years. Cost will be refunded by the club.
- The ability (or can enlist help) to haul containers of water for events.
